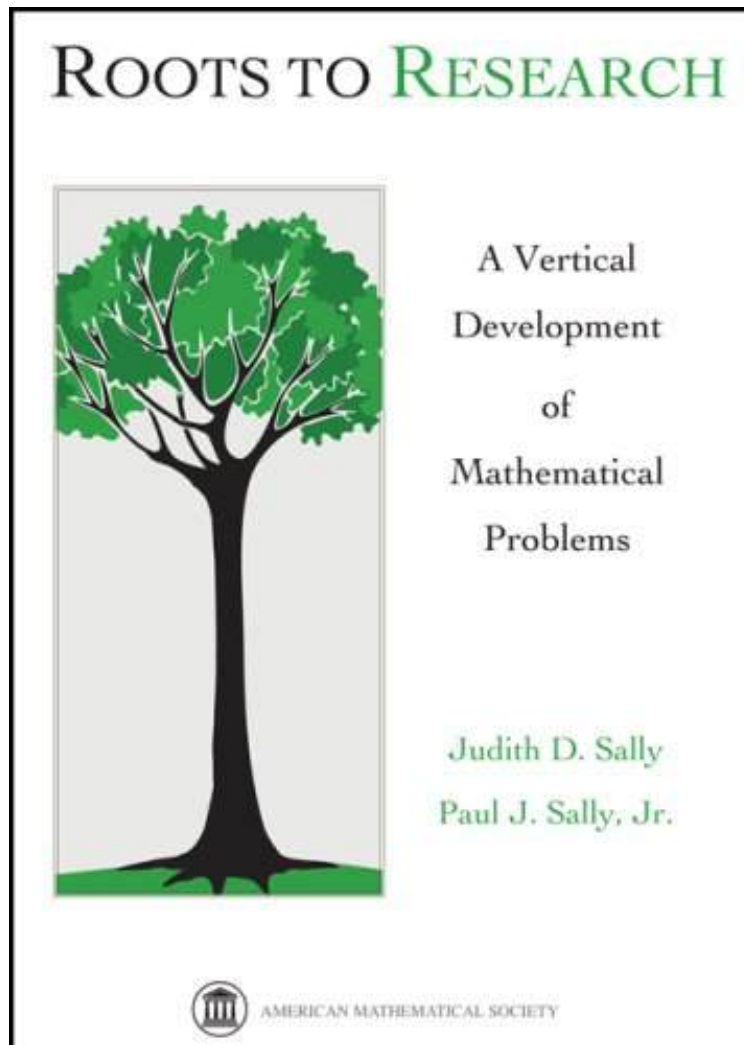

rough outline of the latter's proof is included. It consists of five chapters, out of which two deal with geometry and the rest the number theory. The book includes exercises. Though certain contemporary mathematical problems are of particular interest to teachers and students because their origin lies in mathematics covered in the elementary school curriculum and their development can be traced through high school, college, and university level mathematics. This book is intended to provide a source for the mathematics from beginning to advanced needed to understand the emergence and evolution of five of these problems: The Four Numbers Problem, Ramanujan's Problem, Fermat's Last Theorem, the Goldbach Conjecture, and the Twin Prime Conjecture. I am a huge fan of this book. *Roots to Research* is very accessible, supported throughout with insightful examples and exercises that motivate both the ideas and the formal notation. I recommend this book to future and current math teachers, math majors.
